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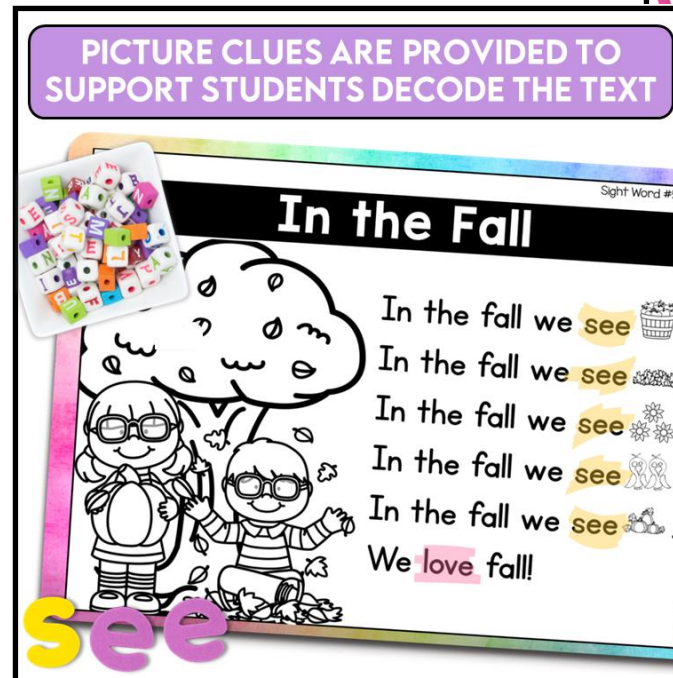

Do you struggle with finding engaging, meaningful activities to use with your students who are struggling with sight words?

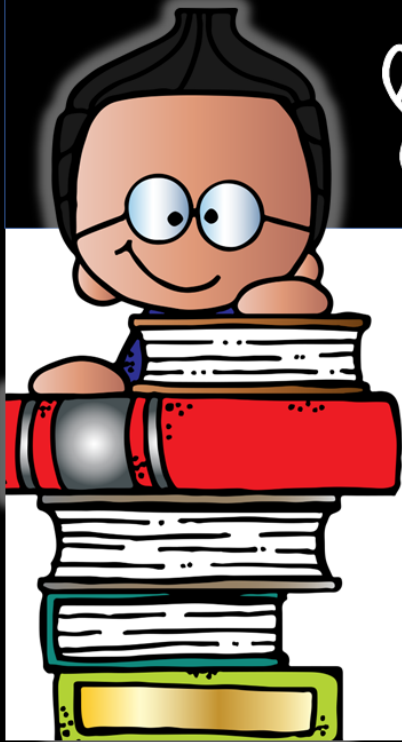

Students will have fun practicing their sight word recognition and fluency for each sight word as quickly as possible! For the Roadrunner Speed Read, I recommend students highlight the focus sight word on the first day. Review the words previously learned and go over any that students may still be struggling with. On the following days, students use this activity as a warm-up when they sit down for intervention. Practice timing students and let them beat their own time! For an added bit of fun, let students use pointers as they read.


ABOUT THIS PRODUCT

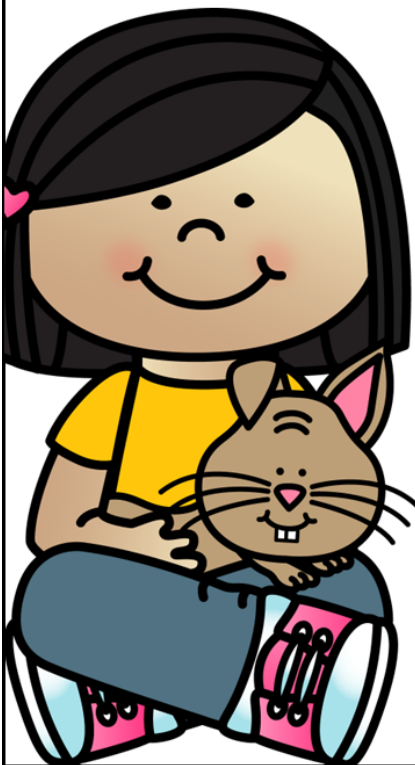

- 1 highlight the focus sight word for that lesson in yellow.

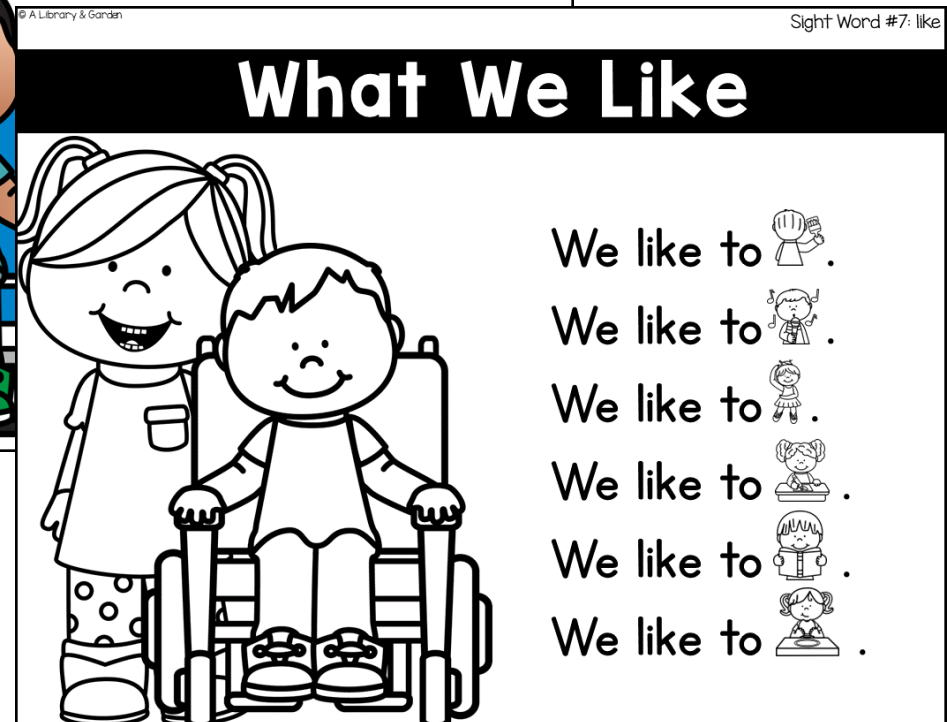
Use a different color highlighter to highlight other known sight words or words that the student can decode independently.

- 3 Next, go back and review unknown words. Practice the text each day until students are fluent with each passage.

Note: Each week spirals over the last so students can review previously learned sight words. Additionally, you'll notice that the fluency passages become more difficult and have fewer picture clues as students progress throughout the program.

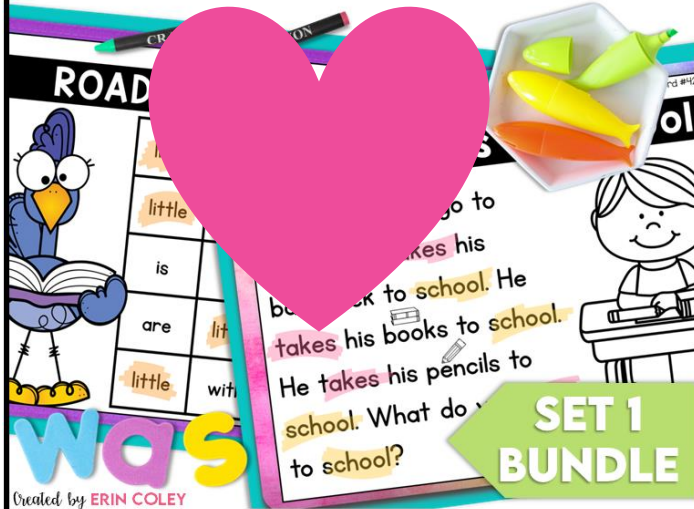
